

WALKING OR WHEELING IS THE SAFEST WAY TO GET TO SCHOOL

Plan your route, find a buddy, and walk or grab your helmet and wheel to school. If this is not possible, follow the steps below to help keep our students safe during drop off and pick up.



WHAT IS A KISS AND RIDE?

A marked lane on a street near a school or on school grounds that is only for the drop off or pick up of students by vehicle. It is designed to reduce traffic congestion and improve student safety during drop off and pick up.



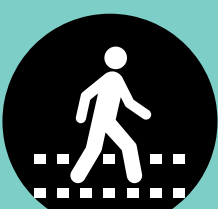
WHAT ARE MY RESPONSIBILITIES AS A DRIVER?

- Time your arrival:
 - AM - before the bell.
 - PM - 5 to 10 minutes after the bell.
- Stop parallel to the sidewalk.
- Do not exit your car. If your child needs help, please park in a designated area.
- Be prepared to stop for pedestrians.
- Make eye contact to ensure pedestrians see you before driving.



WHAT DO I DO IF THERE IS NO SPACE TO SAFELY STOP?

Please do not double park. Wait until it is safe to move forward in the Kiss and Ride lane. Dropping off or picking up your child in the driving lane increases the risk of an accident.



WHAT CAN I DO TO KEEP MY CHILD SAFE WHEN ENTERING OR EXITING THE CAR ALONE?

Review safety tips:

- Enter and exit the car from the passenger side.
- Cross at a crosswalk, if one is available.
- Stay on the sidewalk whenever possible.
- Wait for traffic to come to a complete stop before crossing the street.
- Make eye contact with drivers to be sure they see you before crossing the street.

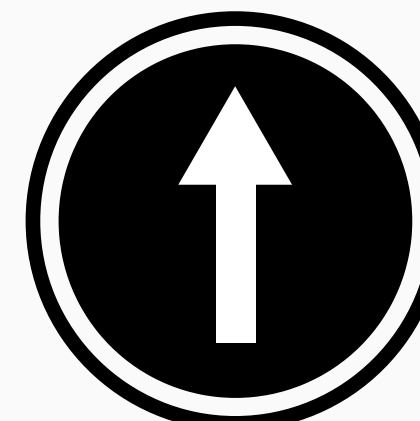
SIMPLE STEPS TO DROP OFF & PICK UP



1 ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL

AM - Please arrive before the bell to avoid traffic congestion and have all backpacks and school supplies ready.

PM - Please arrive 5 to 10 minutes after the bell to avoid traffic congestion.



2 PULL AHEAD

Pull ahead as far as you can in the lane.

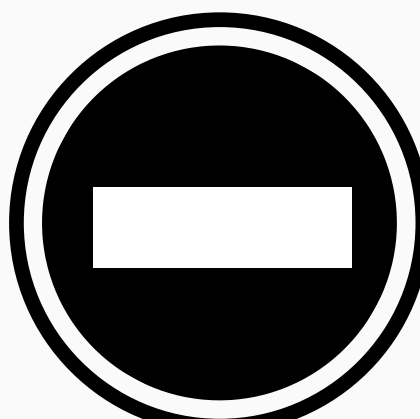
TIP: If you do not see your child in the waiting area, complete a loop.



3 PUT YOUR CAR IN PARK

When it is safe to stop, please put your vehicle in park.

TIP: If you are parked for more than 30 seconds, turn your car engine off to avoid idling.



4 DO NOT EXIT YOUR CAR

If you need to help your child into and/or out of the vehicle, please park in a designated parking area. Drivers should not exit their vehicle in the Kiss and Ride lane.



5 CHILD ENTERS/EXITS CAR

Your child should enter or exit your vehicle without your help. Please have them enter or exit from the passenger side of the vehicle.



6 FOLLOW THE SIGNS

Once your child is safely on the sidewalk or in the vehicle, leave the Kiss and Ride lane by following the signs.
