

WALKABOUT WORKSHEET EXAMPLE

Victoria Public School
November 10, 2011

LOCATION 1: Wharncliffe and Askin

Concerns:

- Cars parked on both sides of street, cars parked in “no parking” area (d/t poorly visible signs)
- **Traffic count shows - 34 cars/day parked in this area**

LOCATION 2: Cynthia and Byron

Concerns:

- Turning Cynthia to Byron – traffic not stopping at signs, poor visibility (d/t greenery)
- Variety of motorized vehicles blocking crosswalks
- French immersion school parents adding to traffic congestion
- **Traffic count shows – 16% walking school population walks down this street**

Comments:

LOCATION 3: Byron and Wharncliffe (North West Side)

Concerns:

- Difficulty crossing, poorly marked crossing area
- Inattentive drivers
- Tim Hortons traffic congestion
- Busy Intersection for one crossing guard
- **Traffic count shows – 25% of walking school population come through north west gate on Byron (would be coming from this intersection)**

Comments:

LOCATION 4: Orchard and Old Springbank

Concerns:

- Vehicle speed
- Area used as a “short cut” for Wharncliffe to Springbank (no left turn from Wharncliffe onto Horton)
- Difficult for children to cross street

LOCATION 5: Horton and Wharncliffe

Concerns:

- Difficult for children to cross
- Vehicle speed and visibility while turning
- ***Five to ten students affected by this area (number varies weekly d/t housing for families in transition)***

Route:

- School exit to Askin Street **[Stop #1]**
- East on Askin to Cynthia
- North on Cynthia to Byron **[Stop #2]**
- West on Byron to Wharncliffe **[Stop # 3 (Tim Hortons)]**
- Continue west on Byron to Orchard
- North on Orchard to Old Springbank **[Stop #4]**
- West on Old Springbank to Brookdale (south side)
- East on Old Springbank to Wharncliffe (north side)
- North on Wharncliffe to Horton **[Stop #5]**
- South on Wharncliffe to school
