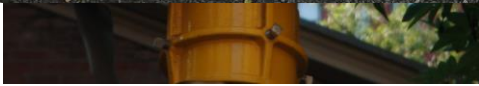

Crossing Safety Tips

	DO	DO NOT
STOP	Stop at curb or edge of street	Run into the street
LOOK	Look for gap in traffic	Cross at a curve or hill or between parked cars
LISTEN	Listen for oncoming cars you can't see	Wear headphones

Mid-block



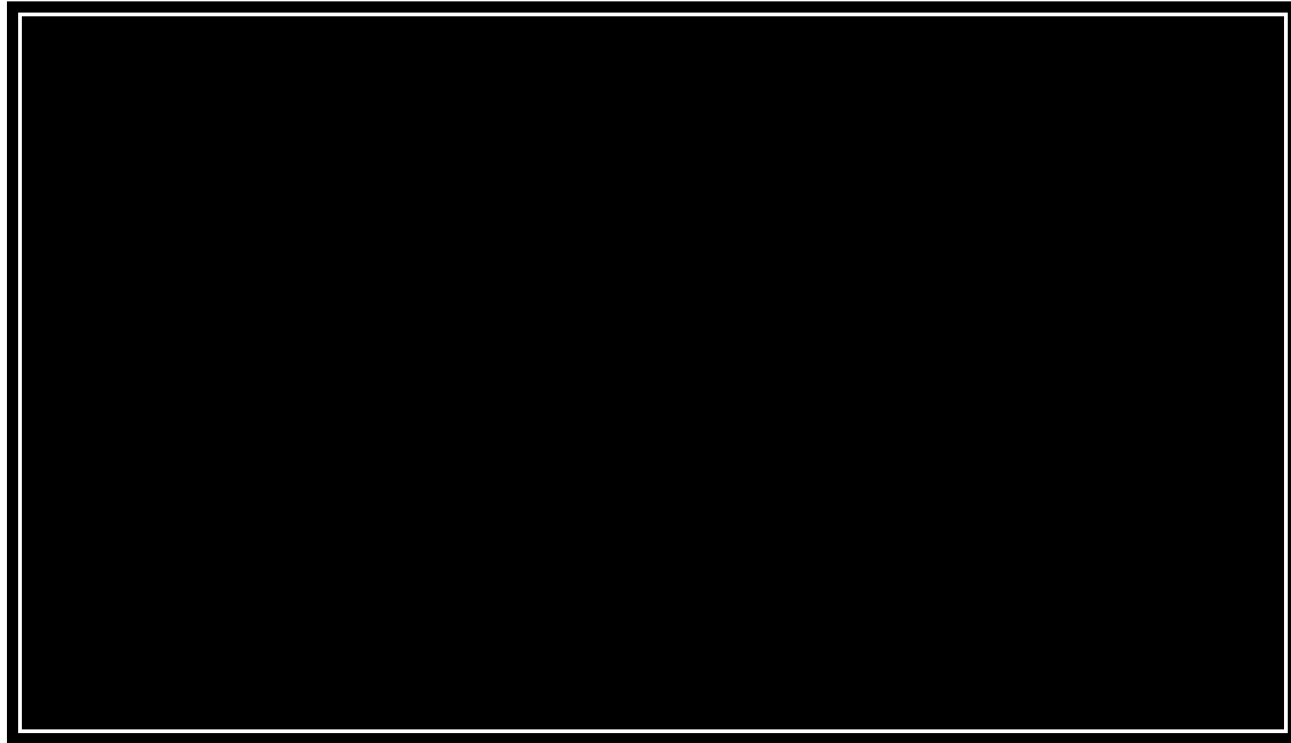
Look left, right, left

Pedestrian Crossovers



Pedestrians

- ➔ Indicate intention to cross
- ➔ Wait for traffic to stop
- ➔ Make eye contact to ensure driver sees you

Cyclists

- ➔ When riding with traffic, follow rules for drivers
- ➔ When crossing, follow rules for pedestrians; dismount and walk your bike across

Drivers

- ➔ Be prepared to stop for pedestrians
- ➔ Stop behind the yield line
- ➔ Make eye contact so pedestrian sees you
- ➔ Wait until pedestrian completely crosses road before proceeding



Fines and penalties
Up to \$500 and 3 demerit points

Driving Safely at a PXO



Using a Roundabout

STOP, LOOK and **LISTEN** for a safe gap in traffic



- Cross the roads one at a time, around the outside
- Point your finger across the crosswalk to tell the drivers you want to cross
- Make eye contact to be sure they see you and stop

Walking in any Weather



Biking Safety

- Walk across the street with your bike.
 - Be alert. No headphones.
 - Be extra careful at driveways.
 - Pedestrians have right of way.

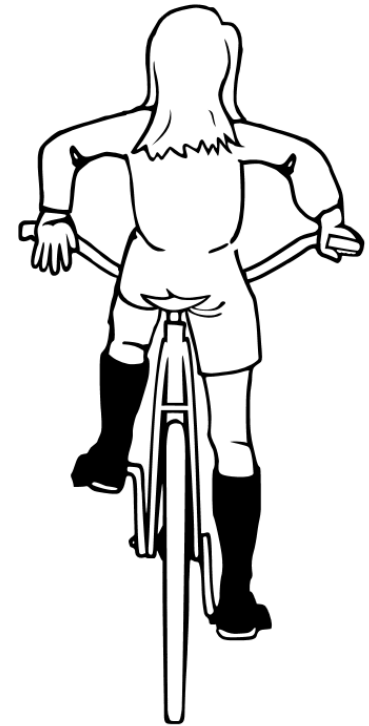
Hand Signals



 **RIGHT turn**

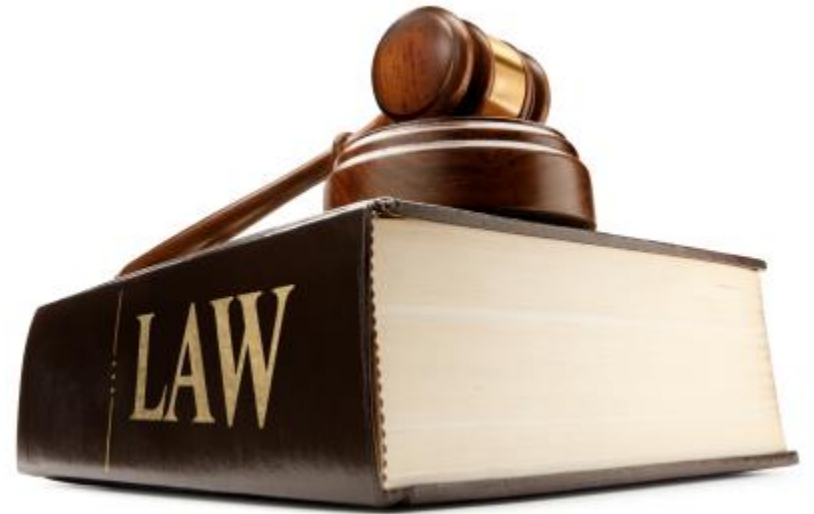


LEFT turn



It Is The LAW To...

- Always wear a helmet
- Obey road signs and traffic laws
- Have reflectors and lights
- Have a bell or horn



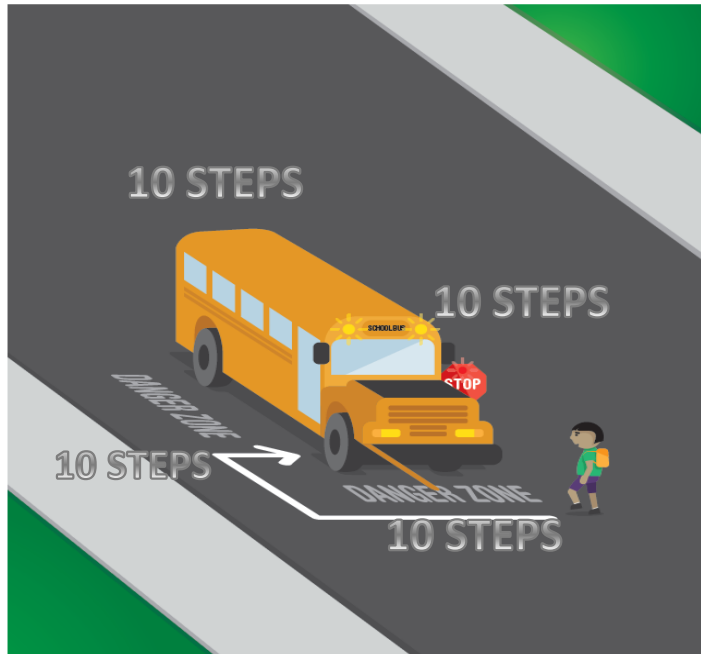
Helmet Safety

- Wear it right
- Do not wear a hat or pony tail underneath
- Do not use stickers
- Replace if: in a crash, cracked, falling apart, it is 5 years old or does not fit
- Check that it meets the Canadian Safety Standards (Look for a stick that says: CSA, CPSC, SNELL, ANSI)

Bus Safety



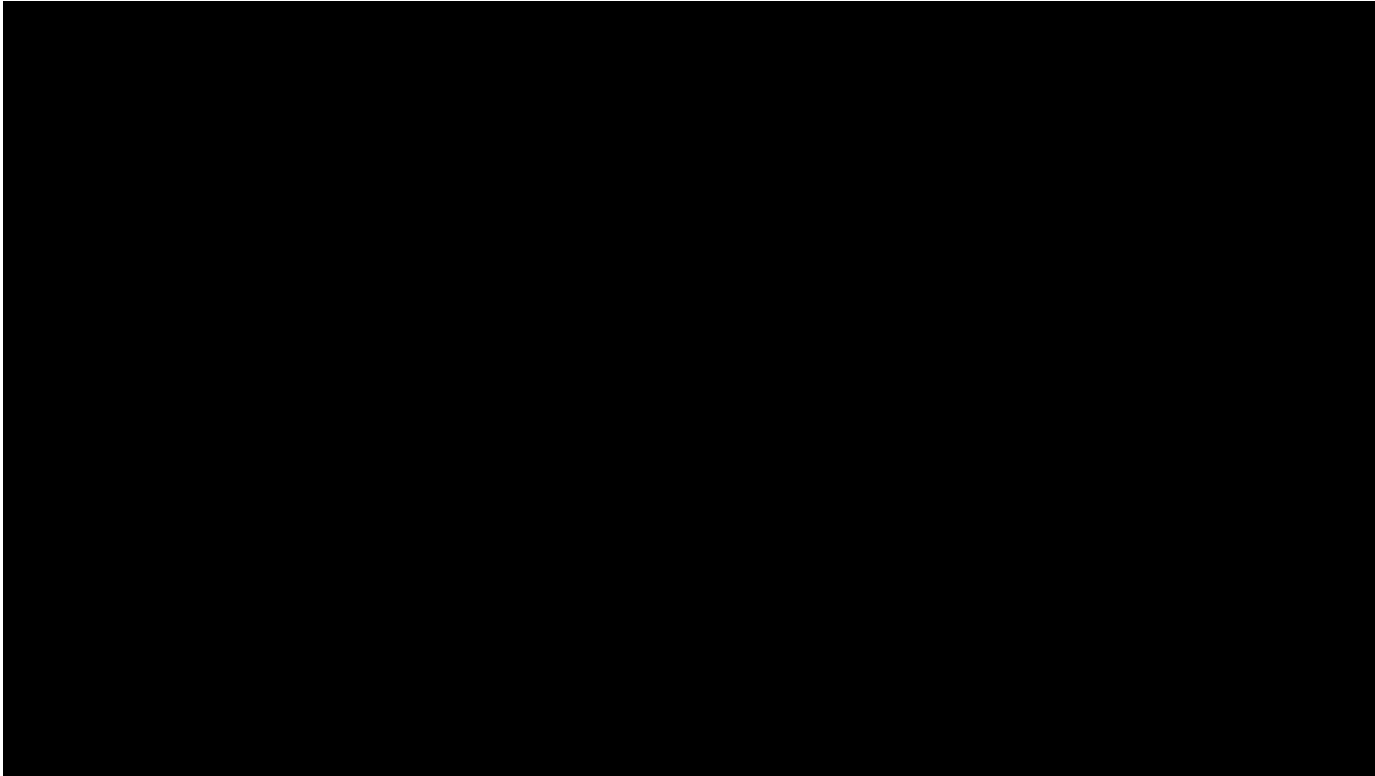

When you Get Off the Bus...

1. Take __ steps out of danger zone
2. Look at driver for signal
3. Go to almost the middle of the street, stop look listen
4. Look left right left, cross
5. If horn, go back and start over
